Whitkirk Club Members Rules

Objectives of the Club

- To protect and develop the interests of sport, generally in the Whitkirk area.
- To develop and extend the amenities of the Whitkirk grounds for the playing of Bowls, Cricket, Football and Tennis and for any other sports.
- To promote social and recreational activities amongst the members.

Membership

The Club is a members' club that consists of ordinary members who are fully paid-up members of one of the following sections:

- Whitkirk Bowling Club
- Whitkirk Cricket Club
- Whitkirk Wanderers AFC
- Whitkirk Lawn Tennis Club

Subscriptions

- Annual subscriptions should be paid upon election and thereafter, without demand, in June of each year. Dates when membership can be renewed will be posted on the notice boards and by our email service towards the end of May.
- Annual Social Club subscription rates are £25 for all members. Members' spouses are automatically covered.
- Only fully paid-up members are entitled to vote at any AGM.

Conduct

The General Committee may suspend or terminate the membership of any person whose conduct, whether on the club premises or elsewhere, is or has been, in the opinion of the committee, prejudicial to the interests of the Club.

Dress Code

Members are expected to maintain a neat and appropriate standard of dress when on Club premises.

Children

- Children are allowed within the Club, but members must be responsible for their children's conduct at all times.
- Once a child reaches the age of 18, they must take out their own membership the following June.

Guests

- Each member is allowed to sign in up to 4 guests on any one day.
- Each guest may only be signed in twice in any calendar month.
- All guests' details must be entered in the visitors' book by the entrance door.
- Members are responsible for their guests' behaviour whilst on Club premises.

Opening Hours

Opening hours are posted on the notice boards and by our email service.

- Bank Holiday extensions and event hours will be notified in advance.
- Various social activities take place during Bank Holidays, with details provided on the notice boards and via email.

Annual General Meeting

The Social Club AGM is held annually in May. Information relating to the AGM will be made available in the Club and by our email service prior to this date. Only fully paid-up members are eligible to vote.
